

RULES FOR CHILDREN / YOUTH

GRIFFIG

1. The climbing hall is not a playground:
Children and teenagers behave considerately.
2. An accompanying adult may supervise a maximum of 4 children and teenagers. A maximum of 2 children/youths in the bouldering area. Supervision must be ensured at all times.
3. Enter the belaying area (light blue line on the floor) and falling zone (orange line on mats) only for climbing/ bouldering.
4. Additional rules apply to the training room, the bouldering area, the bouldering cave and the children's bouldering. These are posted on site.
5. Independent access from the age of 14 (climbing only with appropriate training). Entry form 14-18j signed by legal guardians is a prerequisite.

The legal guardians or accompanying persons are liable for the children and young people.
